- 1. The organisers do not accept liability for any accidents damage, injury to owners, animals, drivers, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.**
- 2. The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class, refunding any fees paid in respect thereof**
- 3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, also substitute any judge without prior warning**
- 4. Refund of entry will only be given on the cancellation of either the class, show or the presentation of a vet certificate.**
- 5. Horses or ponies entered in any class must be 4 years old or over**
- 6. A novice pony is defined as a pony that has not won a first prize in any class.**
- 7. A novice driver is defined as a driver who has not won a first prize in any driven class.**
- 8. The decision of the Judge shall be final.**
- 9. No substitution or nomination entry will be accepted**
- 10. No pony may be entered that has been bred, sold or leased or produced by the judge or his/her immediate family or employer.**
- 11 All M&M ponies entered in the show must be registered with their appropriate breed society.**
- 12 All competitors must have third party public liability insurance, this may be inspected at any time during the show.**
- 13 Animals that behave in an uncontrolled or hazardous manner, in the opinion of either the judges or steward, will be asked to leave the ring or the show.**
- 14 All vehicles, towing or lorries should carry a suitable fire Extinguisher**
- 15 Young Drivers under the age of 18 years must be**
- 16 accompanied in the vehicle by a competent groom aged 18 years or over at all times. Proof of age will be required in the event of any query. The young driver will be judged on the ability of the whip and not entirely on horse/pony or**
